ORDER :-

1. File put up before me being Duty Judge as the learned presiding Officer is on summer vacation.
2. The present bail application has been filed by accused-applicant for grant his regular bail with the contentions that applicant-accused is in judicial custody since 18.3.2021 and is no more required for further investigation. Present false and frivolous F.I.R has been registered against the accused-applicant. Challan the present case has already been presented before the learned court of Ms.Sumukhi, Id.JMIC, Amritsar and

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the same has not yet been committed to the learned Court of Session. Accused-applicant is innocent and he has not committed any offence. Conclusion of trial will take long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant behind bars. Applicant is not likely to abscond nor shall commit any offence while on bail. Applicant undertakes to remain bound by the terms and conditions so imposed by the Court.

3. Notice of the bail application was given to Addl. P.P. for the State, who put her appearance and opposed the bail application .

4. Record received. Arguments on bail heard. Perusal of the file shows that the present FIR was registered on the statement of complainant that on 15.3.2021 the present accused-applicant alongwith co-accused had snatched mobile phone from him and on 19.3.2021 both the accused were arrested and from their possession alleged recovery was effected. Accused applicant is in custody since then. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submitted that co-accused against whom similar allegations were made has been released on regular bail. So, keeping in view the fact that recovery has already been effected and investigation is complete and challan has already been presented, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the present accused-applicant in custody. So, accused-applicant Sukhbir Singh is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Ilaqa/Duty Magistrate subject to the conditions :-

1. That the applicant shall not leave the country without prior

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permission of the Court and to surrender his passport in the trial Court.

2. That the applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
3. That the applicant will appear on each and every date of hearing to be fixed in the trial.
4. That the accused-applicant will abide by the directions issued by the Govt. of Punjab with regard to Pandemic Covid-19.

5. Nothing observed hereby will affect the merits of the case.
