Keeping in view the additional material which
has appeared during “further investigation”, conducted by
DIU, in terms of directions issued by the Hon'ble High
Court, prima facie case for an offence under Section 506 (I)
and 506 (II) IPC is made out against accused he having

criminally intimidated Rajinder Kumar Gupta (since deceased) on 21.02.2016 at 10 pm, near H. No. 5166, Damodar Dass Building, Basant Road, Pahar Ganj, Delhi and 24.02.2016 at 5.30am, on the first floor i.e. in front said H. No. 5166 respectively.

Let additional charge be framed against accused accordingly.
