Sanjay Kumar, husband of deceased Anjali has opposed the interim bail application through Ld. Addl. PP. He is inquired by the court whether he has received any threatening call at any point of time for which he has denied.

Considering the submissions made and in the interest of justice, **interim bail application of applicant / accused Naveen Uppal @ Sunny is allowed to the extent**

that applicant / accused is granted interim bail from 26th , 27th , 28th and 29.04.2017 subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount. It is made clear that the applicant / accused shall not visit the area (Paschim Vihar) where the family of deceased Anjali is residing not he shall threaten or tampered with any evidence. Further applicant / accused is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent thereafter as per rules before sunset. Application is disposed off accordingly. Copy of this order be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for intimation. Copy of this order be given dasti to the Ld. Counsel for applicant / accused Naveen Uppal @ Sunny, as prayed.
