The earlier proxy counsel on behalf of the counsel Ms. Shalini has handed over the file to the newly engaged counsel Sh. Sachin Kumar Jain today.

The earlier counsel Ms. Shalini is discharged accordingly at request. It is stated by accused that as on date he is being represented by Sh. Sachin Kumar Jain, Ld. LAC therefore his earlier counsel Sh. N. K. Chauhan may be discharged accordingly.

At the request of earlier counsel Sh. N. K. Chauhan , the said counsel stands discharged.

One bail application which is filed by earlier counsel Sh. Ganesh Kumar is taken up at his request as it is sought to be argued by him.

Arguments on bail application heard at length.

It is stated that this is the first bail application of accused. He is in JC since April, 2015. Most of the PWs have been examined. There is no chance of tampering with the evidence. As per record. There is no eye witness to the incident. It is prayed accordingly.

Ld. Additional PP on the other hand has strongly opposed the bail application alleging that weapon of offence i.e., knife has been recovered from the accused. Purse of the deceased has also

been recovered from him. DNA profile has been matched as per the FSL report. Blood stains which were found on the clothes of the accused have been matched with the blood of victim. The allegations against the accused are serious in nature therefore, the application is liable to be dismissed.

From the perusal of the record, it is reflected that all the material witnesses except Doctor and the IO have been examined. It is the fag end of the trial. FSL Report is also against the accused which is a matter of record.

Considering the seriousness of offence and the abovesaid factors, I am not inclined to grant the bail to the accused, hence it is dismissed. Copy of the order be given dasti.
