ORDER

This case is not on today's board. The accused has given application at Exh. 02 for taking the case on today's board. Today the accused is present before this Court. He voluntarily submitted that he is ready to plead guilty for the offence leveled against him. He submitted pursis at Exh. 03. His age is of 30 years. He submitted that the offence is first in time and that is the only incident. He was not having intention to commit such offence. He is the poor person and only earning hand of his family. If, he remains in jail then, his family will suffer from starvation. Considering these submissions, as the offence is the first in time and the

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financial condition of the accused, I am of the view that instead of imposing sentence on the accused, imposition of fine only will suffice the purpose. Hence, I proceed to pass following order;

ORDER

1]	Accused Akshay Sandiprao Paravi is hereby convicted as per Section 275 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for an offence punishable under Section 184/177 of the Motor Vehicles Act and accused is directed to pay fine of Rs. 1,000/- (in words rupees One Thousand only) and in default of payment, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.
2)	Bail bond, if any, of accused stands canceled.
3)	Pronounced in open court.
