Matter is fixed for consideration on point of charge.

Ld. Counsel for the accused submits that the alleged contraband recovered from the possession of the accused has been planted upon him. He submits that at the time of recovery of the said contraband, no public witness was joined despite the facts that the accused was apprehended, from a place, which is frequented by numerous public persons.

On the basis of the same, prayer has been made for discharge of the accused from the subject FIR.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State submits that the contraband was recovered from the possession of the accused and that there are sufficient evidence/material on record, which raise grave suspicion against the accused.

Submissions heard.

The arguments raised on behalf of the accused are a matter of trial. Sufficient material is available on record for framing of charges against the accused.

Consequently, let charge under section 18 of NDPS Act be framed against the accused.

Charges under section 18 of NDPS Act framed against the accused, to which he pleads not guilty and claims trials.

Let witnesses mentioned at Sr. No. 1 and 3 be summoned through SHO concerned for NDOH.
