This petition is coming before me for final hearing in the presence of **Sri Yasa Yugander**, Advocate for petitioner/accused No.3; and of Spl. Public Prosecutor for Respondent/Complainant and upon perusing the material papers on record and upon hearing and having stood over for consideration till this day, this court delivered the following:

:: ORDER ::

1. Counter not filed.
2. This court heard the arguments of the counsels appearing for the petitioner/accused No.3 and the learned Special Public Prosecutor.
3. The case of the prosecution case is that on 13.07.2026 the petitioner/ accused No.3 remanded to judicial custody on execution of Non Bailable Warrant.
4. The learned counsel for the Petitioner/accused No.3 submitted that a false case is filed against the petitioner/accused No.3 with false allegations and he is innocent. That the petitioner is the sole earning member to his entire family members and as such his further

detention would cause much hardship to his entire family members. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

5. Perusal of record shows that the accused remanded to judicial custody on execution of Non Bailable Warrant on 13.07.2026. However, the object of the bail is to secure the presence of the accused at the time of trial, and hence this bail is neither punitive nor preventative, deprivation of liberty must be considered as a punishment. Hence, this court is inclined to grant bail to the accused No.3.

6. ***In the result***, this petition is allowed.

(i) The petitioner/accused No.3 is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a personal bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) with two sureties for like-sum each to the satisfaction of this court.

(ii) On such release, petitioner/accused NO.3 is directed to appear before the Station House Officer, P.S Laxmidevipally, twice in a month i.e., on alternate Mondays in between 10.00 am to 12.00 noon for a period of Two months.

(iii) He shall not threaten or intimidate the witnesses and he shall co-operate with the investigating agency as and when required.
