ORDER BELOW EXH.1

1] By this application, the applicant has sought grant of regular bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 is filed by the applicant/accused Mahadev Pralhadrao Umbare seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in connection with Crime No.167/2026 registered with Police Station Majalgaon City, Tq. Majalgaon, Dist. Beed against himself for the offences punishable under Sections 109(1), 115(2), 352, 351(2) read with Section 3(5) of BNS.

2] On 22/05/2026 at about 6.00 p.m. complainant went to Majalgaon Bypass, Hotel Jaya- Veeru. When he came out after drinking tea at the nearby tea house, Sumit, Amol both from Majalgaon, and two other unknown men came to him on a motorcycle. At that time, Sumit Kadam abused him and threatened to kill him, saying, "Stop obsessing over my sister, we will not let your marry with her." Amol Gawde, who was with him, took out knife from his waist and stabbed him on his head with the intention to kill him. The knife hit his left hand's paw, causing a wound. He then stabbed him again on the chest. When

he moved back, the knife hit his left hand's upper arm, causing a wound. He fell down seriously injured. When two unknown persons, who were with applicant/accused, hit his left wrist with a Iron rod and punched him. Amol Gawde again stabbed his right leg with the same knife, causing a wound. Amol Gawde threatened, that if you start a fight or file a case against us, we will file an anti-terrorism case against you. The people gathered there saved him from his clutches and someone called the police and informed them, after which the police immediately came and took him by rickshaw to the Government Hospital, Majalgaon for treatment. The doctors there first treated him and gave him a referral letter and sent him to the Government Hospital, Beed in a ambulance with his relatives. After reaching the government hospital, Beed stitches were taken on the wound on his skin and was admitted to ward No. 48 for treatment. During the treatment, a CT Scan and X-ray of his hand were taken and after seeing the report, the doctors said that his hand was fractured and plastered it. And he is currently undergoing treatment at the Government Hospital, Beed in ward No. 48. Therefore, he filed complaint before Police Station.

3] The applicant denied his involvement in the present crime. Present applicant has been falsely implicated in the present crime. Considering the FIR it is crystal clear that, the allegations made in complaint are not against this petitioner. All the allegations regarding assault by knife & iron rod are against the other accused. Initially a news regarding assault by unknown persons was published in the news papers of

23/05/2026. This fact itself shows that, the complainant has intentionally roped this petitioner by making false allegations. On the relevant date & time this petitioner was not present at or any place near the Jay-veeru Hotel. This fact can be ascertained from the CCTV footage collected/gathered by I.O. from the custody of the owner (i.e. Deepak Ghubade of Jay-Veeru Hotel). The petitioner is an educated person & does not have any type of criminal antecedent therefore, this petitioner deserves the regular bail. From the CCTV footage it clearly reveals that, neither the petitioner nor anybody from his family was present on so called spot of incident at the alleged date and time. Considering the CCTV footage it clearly reveals that the imaginary story generated by the complainant and the complaint lodged against the applicant is false and frivolous. The delay of more than one day caused to lodge FIR to the complainant is not properly explained by the prosecution. The applicant is having agricultural land & household property at Majalgaon & various places. The applicant is not having any past criminal antecedents. The applicant is ready to abide by all the conditions imposed if any by this court while granting regular bail. He is not a habitual offender and undertakes to co-operate with the investigation and abide by any conditions imposed by this Court.

4] I have heard Ld. Advocate Shri. D. D. Dhakane. He vehemently submitted that the role played by the applicant is very minor role. There are false allegations against the applicant. It is to be noted that the date of incident is 22/05/2026 and FIR is lodged on 24/05/2026. The story has

been culminated into the known person by intentionally regarding additional statement and implicating name of these applicant that he instigated to assault victim with the help of main conflict and two absconding accused. He further stated that statement of owner of hotel is recorded. Pen drive is seized. The CCTV footage does not reveal person who assaulted to applicant in commission of offence. The injured is discharged that may be considered and the weapon has been handed over to the police. It is the victim, who wants to grab my property with the help of love affair of my sister.

5] The application is resisted by the Ld. APP Shri. R. A. Waghmare. He strongly objected to release the applicant. He drew my attention that the applicant who arrested in the hospital. He having four cases pending against him. He submitted that the CCTV footage reflects he assaulted by knife. The criminal intention to assault with the knife on vital part but victim is saved and it was sustained assault on leg and shoulder. That may be consider the offence provides punishment up to life imprisonment. Two accused are arrested. If he released on bail he may pressurize witness. Supplementary statement is recorded. It is a case of conspiracy at the instance of applicant Sumit and other accused assaulted victim. I have heard Ld. Advocate Shri. C. M. Satpute for intervenor. He requested to reject the bail.

6] Heard both sides. Perused application and say filed by APP at Exh.5. On the backdrop of complaint allegations are

pertaining to the assault dated 22/05/2026 at 6.00 p.m. on victim Sumit Kadam threatened to bother that he should not harass his sister Amol Gawade assaulted with knife on his wrist and tried to stab informant in his head with intention to kill, but he tried to save and sustained left palm injury. At second time again tried to stab on chest but victim steps that and therefore got injury on left hand. He failed down. Two unknown person i.e. subsequently identified in the investigation as a Mahadev Umbare and one Mr. Kamble. The role assigned to Mahadev Umbare that he assaulted by wooden log and fist and blows. The role assigned to accused Mr. Kamble that he assaulted by fist and blows as well as chair on his head.

7] The learned Advocate for intervenor Adv. C. M. Satpute submitted that, bail shall not be granted. Ld. Adv. C. M. Satpute placed reliance copy of NC case No. 334/2026 dated 06/07/2026 and therefore, prayed that, accused is pressurizing them and hence, bail cannot be granted. I have gone through the fact of the case, it reveals that, the victim is discharged from the Government Hospital, Beed. Most of the investigation belonging to this accused is completed, as the informant has no grievance. It reveals that, the informant was present. He has settled dispute with the main culprit i.e. Amol Gavade in Bail Application No. 207/2026 not with this applicant. The FIR reveals name of Sumit Kadam and Amil Gavade and not of this applicant. Considering these developments, I am of the opinion that, bail needs to be granted. It is settled principle of law that, "Bail is Rule and Jail is exception". He has no any criminal

antecedent. Minor role is attributed to this applicant. No purpose will be suffice by keeping applicant behind bar. He has not criminal antecedents. Hence, order :-

ORDER

1. Criminal Bail Application No. 207/2026 is allowed.
2. In the event of arrest, applicant/accused **Mahadev Pralhadrao Umbare** be released on bail on his executing personal bond of **Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only)** with one surety in like amount in connection with Cr. No. 167/2026 registered at City Police Station, Majalgaon Tq. Majalgaon for offence punishable under Sections 109(1), 115(2), 352, 351(2) read with Section 3(5) of BNS, 2023.
- 3 Applicant/accused to remain present before the Investigating Officer of respondent Police Station on every Saturday in between 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. for next one month, in failure the bail will be cancelled.
- 4 Applicant/accused not to threaten and pressurize the complainant and the witnesses and tamper with the prosecution evidence, in failure of any condition bail will be cancelled.
- 5 Inform to the concerned Police Station.
- 6 In above terms, present Criminal Bail application stands disposed off accordingly.
