



ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN S.C.C. No.278/2022
[Shivanand Nuvrutti Mali v. Mulla Poultry Services through
Proprietor Shabir Masjid Mulla]

The complainant has filed withdrawal pursis (Exh.33).

02. Heard the complainant, learned advocate Shri. R.J.Gorwade for the complainant and learned advocate Shri. S.D.Patil for the accused, at length.

03. Contents of withdrawal pursis (Exh.33) were read over and explained to the complainant. He has voluntarily admitted correctness of contents in withdrawal pursis (Exh.33). He submitted at bar that, the dispute between the complainant and the accused has been amicably settled. The complainant has received amount mentioned in the disputed cheque from the accused. The complainant has not remained any grievance against the accused and hence, he does not want to proceed further against the accused. He lastly prayed that, the case may be disposed of as per withdrawal pursis (Exh.33).

04. Learned advocate Shri. R.J.Gorwade and learned advocate Shri. S.D.Patil supported to submissions of the complainant. They submitted at bar that, the case is amicably settled between both the parties outside the Court. Hence, they prayed that, the case may be disposed of as per withdrawal pursis (Exh.33).

05. Considering submissions of complainant, learned advocate Shri. R.J.Gorwade and learned advocate Shri. S.D.Patil it appears that, the case in hand is amicably settled between both the parties. It further appears that, the complainant has received amount mentioned in the disputed cheque from the accused. The complainant has not remained any grievance against the accused and hence, he does not want to proceed further against the accused. Therefore, in view of above peculiar facts and circumstances, it is just and proper to dispose of

present application as per withdrawal pursis (Exh.33). Accordingly,
I pass following order :-

ORDER

1. In view of withdrawal pursis (Exh.33), the complaint is hereby disposed of as withdrawn under Section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
2. Accused Shabir Masjid Mulla is hereby acquitted of the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act vide Section 257 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
3. Bail bonds of the accused, if any, stand cancelled. He be set at liberty.
4. Court fees be refunded as per rule.
