

**Interim Bail Application No. 509-2026  
STATE Vs. SAURAV @ SAURABH  
FIR NO. 219/2025, PS Crime Branch  
U/s 21/29 NDPS Act**

**This is an application U/s 483 of BNSS, 2023 seeking grant of interim bail to the applicant/ accused Saurav Saurabh S/o Tilak Ram for a period of 15 days.**

IO SI Anil Kumar is absent, however, reply to the interim bail application is filed. Copy be supplied to the Ld. counsel for the applicant/ accused as and when required.

Arguments heard.

Ld. counsel for the applicant/ accused submits that the son namely Rudra of the applicant/ accused, aged about one and half years, is suffering from fever, loose motion and vomiting and he is hospitalized in Jiwan Cheritable Hospital, Mangolpuri, Delhi. He further submits that there is no one in the family of the applicant/ accused to look after his son as his wife is also in JC in some other case.

In view of abovesaid, he requests that the applicant/ accused may be admitted to interim bail for a period of 15 days.

Per contra, Ld. Addl. PP for the State as well as IO (by way of reply) have opposed the interim bail application of the applicant/ accused stating that the father of the applicant/ accused is available with the son of the applicant/ accused. They further submit that the mother of the son i.e. the wife of the applicant/ accused is also filed an interim bail application in case FIR no. 35/2026 of PS Gulabi Bagh. According to them, the present

applicant/ accused as well as his wife are involved in NDPS case of commercial quantity. They further submit that as per the reply of interim bail application of accused Ambe @ Sonia i.e. the mother of the son of accused in the aforesaid FIR, the sister of accused Ambe @ Sonia is available in the hospital to look after the son of the applicant/ accused. They further submit that the mother of the son of the accused may be admitted to interim bail for a period of five days only.

Submissions considered. Record perused.

As per the reply filed by the IO, the son of the applicant/ accused, aged about one and half years old, is undergoing treatment.

Vide separate bail order in case FIR No. 35/26 of PS Gulabi Bagh, the wife of the applicant/ accused namely Ambe @ Sonia is admitted to interim bail for a period of ten days to look after her son. Therefore, in the considered opinion of this Court, there is no need to release the applicant/ accused on interim bail as wife of the applicant/ accused can take care of their son during the period of aforesaid treatment. Hence, I do not find any merits in the present interim bail application. Accordingly, interim bail application of the applicant/ accused **Saurav @ Saurabh** stands **dismissed**.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for applicant/ accused as well as IO concerned. Another copy be sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information.
