An application under Order XI Rule 1(5) CPC for taking on record the certificate under Order XI Rule 6(3) CPC (as amended by the Commercial Courts Act, 2015) read with Section 63 (4) (c) of the Bhartiya Saksha Adhinyam, 2023 along with the said certificate were e-filed by the plaintiff on 24.02.2026, which are now seen on the portal of the court and hard copies thereof have already been placed in judicial file.

Considering the facts and circumstances, in view of the reasons mentioned in the application, in view of the fact that the document sought to be brought on record is not material document but is merely a supporting document qua the electronic record already filed by the plaintiff, in view of the fact that defendant is yet to be served and the defendant will get ample opportunity to cross-examine plaintiff's witnesses qua the document in question, the aforesaid application bearing I.A.
