



ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN REGULAR DARKHAST
No.18/2022

[Shivaji Ramchandra Shete v. Tukaram Hari Patil]

The decree-holder and his learned advocate Shri. G.G.Vhatkar have filed pursis (Exh.30) contending that, the darkhast may be disposed of as fully satisfied.

02. Contents of pursis (Exh.30) were read over and explained to the decree-holder. He has voluntarily admitted correctness of contents of said pursis. He submitted at bar that, the darkhast has been fully satisfied and hence, he does not want to proceed further against the judgment-debtor. He lastly prayed that, in view of pursis (Exh.30) the darkhast may be disposed of. Learned advocate Shri. G.G.Vhatkar supported to submissions of decree-holder.
