As per E-mail letter of the Hon'ble Registrar, Inspection-I bearing outward No.B(Gen)-1001/2025/1684, dated 02nd September, 2025 and the office order of the Hon'ble Principal District and Sessions Judge, Chandrapur, bearing order No./ADMN/1018/2025, dated 04th September, 2025 special drive on five working days i.e. from 08th September, 2025 to 12th September, 2025 organize to dispose of cases under section 256 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter for this order in short referred as "the Crpc") and under section 279 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter for this order in short referred as "the BNSS") as well as under section 258 of the Crpc and under section 281 of the BNSS.

2. Perused record.
3. Heard the learned APP for the State. The learned APP argued according to the record.
4. In view of special drive, the case be taken on today's board.
5. Gone through the record. It appears that, the accused is prosecuted for the offence punishable under section-65(e) of the

Maharashtra Prohibition Act. It also appears that, the present charge-sheet is filed in the year 2022. Matter is of summary nature. The case is more than three years old. The learned predecessor of this court and this court issued summons against the accused, but police machinery failed to secure presence of the accused.

6. In these circumstances, no good purpose would be served by keeping the case pending any more. Hence, this court proceed to passed an order.

ORDER

1. The proceeding is stopped vide section 258 of the Crpc.
2. The accused is discharged.
3. After appeal period is over, the seized liquor be sent to the State Excise Department, Chandrapur for further action and disposal, as per law.
4. Case papers be filed accordingly.
5. Order delivered in an open court.
