ORDER

1. The petition has been filed for anticipatory bail. The accused petitioners are apprehending their arrest in aforesaid case. The bail petition of petitioner nos. 2, 3 & 7 namely Suraj Kumar, Anand Kumar Singh & Balbant Kumar respectively has been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 01.07.2026.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for State.

3. Learned counsel for the accused petitioners have submitted that earlier no other bail petition has been moved on behalf of petitioners before this Court or the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. It is submitted that petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence rather he has falsely implicated in this case. The entire prosecution story is false, fabricated, baseless and concocted one and they have not committed any offence. The instant case is a calculated after through counterblast designed inclusively to build under pressure and mark the unknown violence committed by the informant side. There are general and omnibus allegations of trespass and assault have been distributed in discriminatory among all accused persons showing a clear information of malicious over implication no specific and overt act attributed to each applicant. The allegation of theft of a gold chain is completely fraudulent ornamental only to make the offence non-bailable. Accordingly, prayer has

been made to allow the bail application.

4. Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer for bail.

5. The case of prosecution in brief is that on 02.06.2026 at about 02.00 P.M the petitioners along with other co-accused lashed with lathi, danda and iron rod entered into her house and started abusing her family members. They damage the grill. The co-accused Ananad Kumar Singh dragged and fell her down, due to which she became naked and also assaulted her causing fracture on 03 finger. Further stated that petitioner Dhiraj Kumar and Jagmohan Singh assaulted Gaurav Kumar by lathi and danda, causing injury and co-accused Balbant Kumar assaulted Deepak Kumar with iron rod, causing head injury and blood was oozing out. Co-accused Suraj Kumar and petitioners assaulted Saurav Kumar by lathi and danda. Co-accused Ahilya Devi took away golden chain worth rs. 1,50,000/- from the neck of the informant. Accordingly FIR was instituted.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the record including the case diary. The petitioners are named in the FIR. At present it is alleged that the FIR named accused persons assaulted the informant and her family members, as a result of which, they were injured. On perusal of case diary it seems that in para 15 & 16 there is a statement of witnesses have supported the prosecution story. As per injury report report of informant Rina Devi reflects that diffuse swelling with pain left hand and lacerated wound on below nail, marize left thumb 1/4' X 1/4' X 1/6' and refer to Sadar Hospital, Hajipur for x-ray of left hand wrist AP & Lat and report no. 1 is grievous in nature caused by hard & blunt substance because fracture at left index finger and injury no. 2 is simple & hard and caused by blunt substance. Further injury report of Deepak Kumar shows that abrasion on right shoulder & upper broader of right scapular size 1/4' X 1/4' and nature of injury is simple, caused by hard and blunt substance. Further injury report of Gaurav Kumar shows that diffuse swelling with tenderness below joint & forearm, diffuse swelling with tenderness on forehead and refer to Sadar Hospital, Hajipur for x-ray of left left forearm AP & Lat and report no. 1 is simple in nature caused by hard & blunt substance because x-ray shows no fracture and further injury report of Saurav Kumar shows that diffuse swelling with pain head, abrasion on mild head 1/10' X 1/10', redness of left scapular region and diffuse swelling with pain on left hand, refer to Sadar Hospital, Hajipur for x-ray of left hand AP & Lat and report no. 4 is simple in nature caused by hard & blunt substance because x-ray shows no fracture. There are general and omnibus allegation against these petitioner. Further the petitioners claimed as clean antecedents. There is no specific allegation of assault against any of the petitioner. Earlier regular bail petition of other co-accused persons have been granted by this Court vide B.P.

Further having regard to the aforesaid facts and submission advanced by the parties and considering the nature of allegation against petitioners as well as claimed as clean antecedent, this court finds fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Dhiraj Kumar Singh (petitioner no. 1), Jagmohan Singh (petitioner no. 4), Sunil Singh @ Sunil Kumar (petitioner no. 5) & Hanuman Kumar (petitioner no. 6). The petitioners are directed to be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within 30 days of this order, on furnishing the bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS with further conditions that:- i.) Further if after the investigation, I.O files C.S/F.F in some graver offence, then the petitioners shall have to seek a bail afresh. ii.) The Ld. Court shall also fix the date during the course of investigation for their presence in the Court. iii.) The petitioner shall file undertaking before the Ld.
