ORDER ON SUPERDARI

1. This is an application moved on behalf of applicant / owner Smt. Lalita for release of vehicle No. DL 6S BF 8531 (Bullet-350) on superdari.
2. Report from IO has been received wherein police has no objection for releasing the aforesaid vehicle No. DL 6S BF 8531 (Bullet-350) to its rightful / registered owner.

4. In these circumstances, the abovesaid vehicle No. DL 6S BF 8531 (Bullet-350) be released to registered owner / applicant Smt. Lalita subject to the following conditions and the directions to the concerned SHO, in pursuance of the judgment “**Manjeet Singh Vs State**” CrI. M.C. No. 4485/2013 & CRI M.A. No. 16055/2013:-

(i) The vehicle be released to the applicant after

preparation of detailed panchnama;

(ii) Colour photographs of the vehicle be taken which shall be attested or counter signed by the complainant, accused as well as by the person to whom the custody is handed over (if the accused is not available to be signed by two independent witnesses);

(iii) Security bond of suitable amount be taken from the applicant, to the satisfaction of the SHO concerned;

(iv) Valuation report of the vehicle be also prepared:

(v) The photographs alongwith negative / CD, Panchnama and valuation report be filed in the Court within 07 days of release of the vehicle.

5. Accordingly, application stands disposed off in above terms. Copy of order be given dasti to applicant or her counsel. Copy of this order be also sent to the concerned SHO through Naib Court for compliance.
