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treatment where his treatment was conducted properly and his fracture has been healed. Medical Reports pertaining to applicant / accused have been perused and perusal of the same shows that he has been getting proper treatment from BSA Hospital. Further, Jail Superintendent is also directed to provide further proper treatment as per rules as the applicant/accused is still complaining pain in his leg.

Keeping in view of Medical Status Report including recent X-Ray report, the present application is disposed off, accordingly.
