File taken up today on an application U/s. 483 BNSS for seeking grant/extension of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu**.

Reply to the above said application has been received from IO. Same is taken on record. Copy of the same supplied to Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused suffering from severe brain stroke/Neuro attack in the intervening night of 06-07.10.2025 and the applicant/accused was rushed to the emergency ward of GB Pant Institute by his friend on 07.10.2025. It is further submitted that applicant/accused was informed by the doctors at G B Pant Institute that the surgery of the applicant/accused would planned in the next week after a pre-surgery investigation which will take 2-3 days for proper assessment and the applicant/accused will also be kept under observation. It is further submitted that if the present medical condition of the applicant/accused is not treated timely, the same can seriously affect the physical and mental health of the applicant/accused. 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medical documents of applicant/accused is also annexed with the application. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed.

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

The present application has been moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** on the ground that applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** is suffering from severe brain stroke/Neuro attack. As per the reply of IO, applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** does not require surgery and the treatment can be managed with medication only. Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** has contended that the said opinion has not been given by treating doctor and therefore, same has no relevance and therefore, interim bail may kindly be extended. However, perusal of the verification of medical

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documents filed by IO clearly shows that in reply to the notice given to Medical Superintendent BLK Max Superspecialty Hospital, Rajender Nagar, New Delhi, Dr. Kapil Goyla, Medical Superintendent, BLK Max Superspecialty Hospital, Delhi has clearly mentioned that no surgery date of the patient has been finalized as yet and patient is currently under treatment with medicines. Thus, in view of the afore-mentioned report, it is clear that there is no urgency for extension of interim bail of applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu**.

Keeping in view of above discussion and particularly in view of the fact that allegations leveled against applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** are serious in nature, this Court is not inclined to further extend the interim bail of applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu**. The present application for extension of Interim bail of applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** is hereby dismissed accordingly. However, three days time has been given to applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** for making surrender before concerned Jail Authorities.

Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion the merits of the case. Copy of order be given dasti to

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the applicant/accused. The present interim bail application along with the proceedings be tagged with the main case file.
