It is jointly submitted by Ld. Counsels for petitioner
and respondent no. 3 insurance company that matter has been
amicably settled.

It is submitted by respondent no.3 that the insurance
company has agreed to pay total sum of **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees
Twenty Thousand only)** to the petitioner towards full and final
settlement of claim of the injury sustained by injured/petitioner
in the accident in question. The petitioner has accepted the same.

Separate statement of the petitioner as well as Ld.
Counsel for respondent no.3 qua aforesaid settlement, have been
recorded separately. Their statements are accepted by this
Tribunal. In the statement, the petitioner has stated that she does
not have any bank account and the compensation may be
transferred in the bank account of her son Sh. Sharad Kumar.
Copy of his aadhar card is placed on record.

In view of the aforesaid statements, vide separate
detailed order, an award in the total sum of **Rs.20,000/-** is passed
in favour of the petitioner with direction to respondent no. 3

insurance company to deposit the said settlement amount either with the bank account of this Tribunal in SBI, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi or in the bank account of the son of the petitioner within 30 days from today, failing which the respondent no. 3 shall be liable to pay interest @ 12% p.a. for the delay caused by the respondent no. 3.

On realization of the award amount of **Rs.20,000/-**, same be released to the petitioner, as per the details mentioned in the separate award, upon producing the Aadhar Card, PAN Card and Bank Passbook.

Copy of the award be given to the parties free of cost.

Copy of the award be also sent to the court of concerned Metropolitan Magistrate and Delhi State Legal Services Authority (DSLISA).

The Detailed Accident Report (DAR) which was registered as Claim Petition, is disposed of as settled.

Civil Nazir is directed to prepare the miscellaneous file for compliance and put up on **07.10.2026**.

File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
