Award

1. Statements of the petitioner and Ld. Counsel for respondent no. 3/Sh. Shivam Chandel have been recorded in the court today and same is a part and parcel of this award. In view of the above statements recorded on 07.09.2026, award in this regard is passed for payment of **Rs.20,000/-** in favour of the claimant/petitioner and against respondent no.3 insurance company. **The entire award amount shall be payable by Respondent no. 3 to the petitioner on behalf of the all Respondents.**

2. The entire award amount shall be released to the petitioner in her son's bank account namely Sh. Sharad Kumar maintained in a nationalized bank situated near the place of his/her residence immediately.

3. **The respondent no.3 insurance company is directed to deposit the settlement amount with the bank account of this Tribunal at SBI, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi within 30 days from today. Respondent/Insurance Company**

shall deposit the award amount within 30 days from the date of Award by way of NEFT or RTGS mode in the account of concerned Tribunal maintained with SBI, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi (account holder's name-Motor Accident Claims Tribunal 01 Central, A/C No. 42704293960, IFSC Code SBIN0000726) under intimation to the petitioner and concerned Tribunal in terms of the format for remittance of compensation as provided in Divisional Manager Vs. Rajesh, 2016 SCC Online Mad. 1913 (and reiterated by Hon'ble Supreme Court in the orders dated 16.03.2021 and 16.11.2021 titled as Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Co. Pvt. Ltd. Vs. Union of India & Ors), failing which the respondent no. 3 shall be liable to pay interest @ 12% per annum for the delay caused by the respondent no. 2.

Award is accordingly passed.
