ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose off bail application under the provision of Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed by applicant/accused in case FIR No. 111 dated 20.06.2025, registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and Sections 117(2), 118(2) of BNS added later on vide GD No.21 dated 01.07.2025, at Police Station Shri Hargobindpur.

2. Upon notice, learned Additional P.P. put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application. Sh. Lalit Prashad and Sh. Sahil Kamboj, Advocates, appeared on behalf of the complainant. Police record was also requisitioned.

3. The brief facts of the prosecution case are that the present FIR

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under Section 115(2), 118(1), 3(5) of BNS was registered on the statement of complainant Baljit Singh son of Makhan Singh recorded on 20.06.2025 with ASI Sakattar Singh, wherein he alleged that he is an agriculturist. On 13.06.2025 at about 5.30 AM, he along with his uncle's son Sikandar Singh went to his fields for watering his fields. Baldev Singh son of Wassan Singh and Hardev Singh son of Harbans Singh were digging holes in their fields near their motor. When he started watering his fields by starting motor, Hardev Singh armed with dattar and Baldev Singh came to them with empty hands abusing them and Baldev Singh raised lalkara to catch hold them and teach a lesson for forcibly watering from their motor, upon which Hardev Singh gave dattar blow, which hit on his left leg below the knee, then Baldev Singh punched him twice with his right hand, which hit on his left eye. He fell down on the ground. While he was lying on the ground, Hardev Singh gave dattar blow, which hit on his back below the spine, then Baldev Singh punched him again, which hit on his upper lip. Sikander Singh raised raula and assailants ran away from the spot with their weapons. Sikandar Singh arranged the vehicle and got him admitted in Civil Hospital Qadian, where he was medico legally examined. Offence under Sections 117(2) and 118 (2) has been added on receiving X-ray report vide DDR No. 21 dated 01.07.2025.

4. Sh. Vikrampal Singh Pindarori, Advocate, appearing on behalf of applicants/accused submitted that applicants/accused are innocent and falsely implicated in the above said case due to political vendetta. Applicants/accused have nothing to do with the alleged offence. Applicants/accused are only bread winner of their family members. Applicants/accused are ready to join the investigation and to surrender before the investigating officer as and when directed by the Court. Thus, he prayed that applicants/accused may be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional P. P. assisted by learned counsels for the complainant opposed the bail application on the ground of gravity of offence and thus he prayed for dismissal of bail application.

6. ASI Sakattar Singh, No. 2697/BTL, Posted at Police Station Shri Hargobindpur came present along with record and suffered statement that the present FIR under Sections 115(2), 118(1), and 3(5) of BNS was registered on the statement of complainant Daljit Singh against accused namely present Hardev Singh and Baldev Singh. Offence under Sections 117(2) and 118 (2) has been added on receiving X-ray report vide DDR No. 21 dated 01.07.2025. At present investigation in this case is pending qua Sections 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 118(2) and 3(5) of BNS. Injury of Section 118(2) of BNS is attributed to accused/applicant Hardev Singh and injury of Section 117(2) of BNS is attributed to Baldev Singh. No bail application of accused Hardev Singh and Baldev Singh are pending in any Court in this FIR. Accused Hardev Singh and Baldev Singh are not involved in any other case.

7. Perusal of police record as well as statement of ASI Sakattar Singh shows that applicants/accused have nominated in this case and one grievous injury has inflicted on the left eye of the complainant and one another grievous injury with sharp edged weapon has inflicted on the left leg of the complainant. Though, it is argued by learned counsel for the applicants/accused that cross version has also got recorded by the applicants/accused party, but it is apparent from police record that two grievous injuries have suffered by the complainant and even his eye has operated. Investigation is pending on material facts and this Court is of the opinion that applicants/accused are not entitled for pre-arrest bail after inflicting grievous injuries on the person of complainant. In view of the circumstances, bail application is dismissed being without merits. Police record be returned and bail application file be consigned to the record room.
