

State Vs. Chander Kant @ Sonu & Ors.

Mr. Pulkit Chaudhary, Ld. Proxy counsel for Mr. Kamal, Ld. Counsel for the accused persons, namely, Chander Kant @ Sonu and Nilesh @ Kale.

Accused, namely, Chander Kant @ Sonu is present.

Accused Nilesh @ Kale is not present.

Accused Guru Kumar @ Garia is not present.

Ld. Addl. PP for the State has been assigned with additional duty in the Court of Ld. Principal District & Session Judge (Headquarters).

As per the report of non-bailable warrants issued against the accused, namely, Guru Kumar @ Garia, it is observed that same has returned unexecuted with the remarks that accused was not found traceable at his address available on record.

Mr. Purushotam, surety of the accused Guru Kumar @ Garia has entered appearance and requested for a one opportunity to produce the said accused before this Court. It is submitted by Mr. Purushotam that he endeavored to contact the accused, however, he was not found traceable. However, the surety has requested for one opportunity in the interest of justice. Let the same be done, as prayed for.

Request for exemption is made by / on behalf of accused Nilesh @ Kale on the ground that his daughter is ill. For the reasons stated therein, the exemption is allowed for today only subject to the accused furnishing the necessary medical documents on the next date of hearing or in the alternate, on the accused depositing a fine of Rs. 1000/- with DLSA, Central, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi.

At this stage, Ld. Counsel for accused Chander Kant has moved an application for waiver of cost imposed on the accused on the last occasion, while cancelling NBWs against the said accused. Ld. Counsel has submitted that he is now in receipt of the documents, which show that the said accused could not enter appearance before this Court on 10.03.2026 due to the birth of his grand child. Ld. Counsel has submitted that the accused would also furnish the fresh surety during the course of the day.

Heard. Perused.

Notably, on the last occasion, this Court had specifically observed that no documents were forthcoming along with the application for cancellation of NBWs. However, considering that the documents have now been filed, in the interest of justice, the fine imposed on the last occasion is reduced to Rs. 1000/- to be deposited by accused Chander Kant @ Sonu with DLSA, Central, Tis Hazari, Delhi during the course of the day. Further, the accused is directed to furnish fresh surety during the course of the day, in terms of the last order.

In the interest of justice and as prayed for, list for arguments on 20.07.2026.

Issue fresh non-bailable warrants against the accused, namely, Guru Kumar @ Garia and notice under Section 446 Cr.P.C./Section 491 BNSS against his surety, namely, Mr. Purushotam for the next date of hearing.

Issue notice to the concerned IO to be *physically* present before this Court on the next date of hearing.
