Fresh DAR has been filed by the IO/SI Madan Lal. It be checked and registered, as per rules.

The IO has filed the DAR. Copies of DAR have been supplied to the petitioner and respondents.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has filed Vakalatnama. The same is taken on record.

The IO submits that DL of the driver has already been verified and the same is valid.

As per Articles 21 & 22 of the Procedure for Investigation of Motor Vehicle Accidents (See Rule 150A), Central Motor Vehicles (fifth Amendment) Rules, 2022, the DAR is treated as a claim petition under section 166, Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

The respondents shall file their written statement/reply within 30 days from today and supply an advance copy of the same to the petitioner at least two days before the next date of hearing.

Further, the petitioner shall comply with the following directions :

Contd.../-

1. Open a savings bank account (if not already opened) in a nationalized bank, nearest to his/her/their place of residence.
2. Produce copy of his/her/their PAN Card.
3. Original passbook be produced on next date with compliance of following direction:-

- a) Photograph of the account holder on the passbook with stamp and initial signature half on photograph and half on bank passbook.
- b) Parentage of account holder.
- c) It shall also mentioned the following necessary endorsement:-

“No cheque-book and ATM Card has been issued and same shall not be issued without the prior permission of this Court”

Copy of this order be given *dasti* to Ld. Counsel for the petitioner(s) for compliance.

FAR stands disposed off in view of the filing of DAR and the same be tagged with the main file.

List for filing of replies / written statements by the respondent(s) and framing of issues on **12.08.2025**. Advance copy of the same be supplied to Ld. Counsel for the petitioner at least one week before next date of hearing.
