Pursuant to complete abstinence of work and a call for strike by the Lawyers refraining the entry of even the Ld. Public Prosecutor, *Naib* Courts etc., appearance by State and other parties is being made through video conferencing mode.

Present : Mr. Amit Dabas, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.

Accused, namely, Kedari Lal is present on bail.
Accused Shiv Kumar is not present.

IO ASI Bhupender Singh, PW HC Rajesh Kumar and PW Sandeep Beniwal are not present. However, considering a call for strike by the Lawyers, no adverse order is passed against them.

PW Ankit Beniwal has entered appearance through video conferencing mode and submitted that owing to his accident, which he had met in the present case and consequent complications in his legs, he would not be in a position to attend the proceedings today. For the reasons so stated, exemption is allowed for today only.

Accused Shiv Kumar has not entered appearance despite repeated calls.

Issue bailable warrants in the sum of Rs. 5,000/- against accused Shiv Kumar returnable on the next date of hearing.

Request for adjournment has been made by the accused Kedari Lal on the ground of Lawyers' strike.
