An application under Order VI rule 17 read with Section 151 CPC filed on behalf of petitioner along with amended petition.

Since there were some typographical mistakes in the original petition, application is allowed.

Let the amended petition be filed on record.

Present transfer petition has been filed seeking transfer of case no. SC/73/2021 title, '*State vs Akash @ Amit & Ors.*' FIR No. 193/2019 PS Prasad Nagar u/s. 302/323/34 IPC pending in the court of Sh.Virender Kumar Kharta, Ld. ASJ (FTC-02), Central and revision petition bearing no.511/20225, title, '*Himanshu Chahal vs State & Ors*' pending in the court of Sh.Nishant Garg, Ld. ASJ-06, Central, to one court.

It is stated both the cases are outcome of one and the same incident of same date and there are two FIRs. The accused in FIR No. 193/2019 PS Prasad Nagar are witness in FIR No. 193/2020 PS Prasad Nagar and respondent no.2 Himanshu is accused. The revision petition is also with regard to summoning of respondent no.2 / Himanshu Chahal for the offence under Section 307/34 IPC wherein Dushyant Rajora and Deepak Rajora are injured person.

Ld. Counsel for respondent no.2 submits that he has no objection if the present transfer petition is allowed.

Considering the application, for the sake of judicial convenience and since both the cases are connected and Ld. Counsel for respondent has no objection, it is appropriate if both the cases are to be tried by one and same court.

Accordingly, criminal revision bearing no.511/2025, Himanshu Chahal vs State & Ors. is withdrawn from the court of Sh.Nishant Garg, Ld. ASJ-06, Central and is assigned to the court of Sh.Virender Kumar Kharta, Ld. ASJ (FTC-02), Central for adjudication and disposal as per law.

Parties to appear before the court of Sh.Virender Kumar Kharta, Ld. ASJ (FTC-02), Central on 20.07.2026.

Ahlmad of Transferor court is directed to send the file to Transferee court immediately.

Copy of order be sent to both the courts for compliance.

Transfer petition is accordingly disposed of and be consigned to the record room.
