Present transfer petition has been filed under Section 24 CPC seeking transfer of suit bearing CS 601136/2016, titled, '*Manju Bala Ratawal vs Harish Chand*' pending before the court of Sh.Sunil Khatri, Ld. Civil Judge-06, Central to the court of Sh.Anil Paswan, Ld. District Judge-15, Central where another suit bearing CSDJ 614015/2016, titled '*Harish Ratawal vs Ajit Kumar Ratawal*' is pending trial.

Ld. Counsel for petitioner submits that parties in both the suits are similar and the issues are inter-connected. If both the suits are tried separately, there may arise of contradictory judgments and leading to a waste of precious judicial time.

Ld. Counsel for respondent strongly opposed the transfer petition on the ground that matters have been in different courts since 2016 and both the cases are at their final stage. Ld. Counsel further submitted that cause of action, parties to both the

suits as well as jurisdiction is different, therefore cases should not be consolidated or transferred.

In view of facts and circumstances and since both the cases are at their final stages, I am not inclined to transfer the cases in one court.

Transfer petition is accordingly dismissed.
