This is an application filed under Sec. 484 BNSS seeking reduction of surety amount on behalf of applicant/accused Vicky @ Vijay.

Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant submits that accused/applicant was granted regular bail by this court vide order dated 07.05.2026 and he is not in a position to furnish surety bonds in sum of Rs. 15,000/- due to which he is languishing in Jail and hence the amount of surety bonds may kindly be reduced to Rs. 5,000/-. She further submits that as per the law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **SMWP (Crl no. 4/2021 dated 31.01.2023)** accused/applicant is entitled to be released on personal bond or the bail conditions should be modified and hence the present bail application should be allowed.

Ld. Addl. PP for the State submits that he has no objection in this regard.

I have heard the submissions and perused the record.

The accused/applicant was granted regular bail by this court vide order dated 07.05.2026 and till date he could not furnish bail bonds due to poverty. Hon'ble Supreme Court of

India SMWP (Crl no. 4/2021 dated 31.01.2023) has held that in cases where the under-trials are not able to furnish bail bonds within one month from the date of grant of bail then in appropriate cases the Court may consider for the relaxation/modification of conditions laid down in the bail order and may also consider granting temporary bail for a specified period to the accused so that he can furnish bail bond or surety bonds. Accused cannot be kept in J.C. for long only on the ground that he is not in a position to furnish surety bonds. Since the accused is not in a position to furnish surety bond in sum of Rs. 15,000/-, I deem it appropriate to relax the conditions laid down in the bail order dated 07.05.2026.

Accordingly, the present application is hereby allowed. The amount of surety bonds in bail order dated 07.05.2026 stands modified to Rs. 5,000/- from Rs. 15,000/-. Other bail conditions mentioned in bail order dated 07.05.2026 shall remain unchanged.

The application is disposed off accordingly. A copy of this order be given dasti to Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant.

A soft copy of this order be sent to Jail Superintendent today itself through e-mail as per the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SMWP(Crl) no. 4/2021 vide order dated 31.01.2023.
