Present transfer petition has been filed seeking transfer of case bearing no. ***CS DJ 161/2025, titled 'Shanti Sawrup Sethi vs Maya Devi & Anr'*** pending in the court of Sh.Sumeet Anand, Ld. District Judge-11, Central to the court of Sh.Anil Kumar Paswan, Ld. District Judge-15, Central where suit bearing no.CSDJ 1105/2025 is pending adjudication. It is stated both cases have been arisen out of the same property and parties are substantially the same.

Ld. Counsel for respondent submits that he has no objection if both the cases are to be tried by one and same court.
