

MHKO080007212022 	<u>Common Order Below Exh. Nos. 21, 22 & 23 in Misc. Civil Appeal. No.50/2022</u>
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The appellants have filed these applications for setting aside abatement after condonation of delay of 8 months and bringing LRs of deceased respondent No.1 Yashoda Arjun Suryawanshi. It is mentioned in the applications that, deceased respondent No.1 Yashoda Arjun Suryawanshi died on 26/10/2023. It is also submitted that, the information and other details of the LRs were not received in time and therefore, the delay has been caused. Hence, appellants filed these applications for bringing the LRs of deceased respondent No.1 on record after condonation of delay and setting aside the abatement.

02. The respondents have objected these applications by filing say at Exh.25.

03. Reasons mentioned in the applications appears to be satisfactory to condone the delay and setting aside abatement. The proposed LRs i.e. respondent No.2 Megha Arjun Suryawanshi is already on record. Therefore, these applications deserves to be granted.

ORDER

- 1) Applications below Exh. Nos. 21, 22 & 23 are hereby allowed.

- 2) Delay caused in bringing LR's of deceased respondent No.1 Yashoda Arjun Suryawanshi is condoned and abatement is set aside.
- 3) Appellants are permitted to bring the LR's of deceased respondent No.1 Yashoda Arjun Suryawanshi on record and to carry out necessary amendment in the appeal memo (Exh.1) within 14 days from today.
- 4) After carrying out amendment, appellant shall file amended copy of the appeal memo (Exh.1).
