

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN SPL(C) MA NO.322 OF 2014.

This is the bail petition filed by applicant as per Sec.439 of Cr. P. C.

2] The say of applicant is that he was arrested by Wakad police in CR No.15/2014 under S. 354 of IPC and under S. 11 r/w 12 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012. He is in MCR since 11-09-2014. It is his say that the say of complainant is that victim girl and applicant were working together in the lab. On 11-09-2014 when victim girl was alone in the land, applicant touched her from back side and tried to kiss her. The say of applicant is that he did nothing and he prayed for bail.

3] State appeared and objected the application.

4] I heard the submission of both the sides. Following points arise for my determination. I record my points and findings together with for the reasons stated below.

Points**Findings**

1] Whether applicant is entitled to bail ?

– Yes.

2] What order ?

– Application is allowed.

REASONS**All points. :-**

5] After perusal of police record, I found that after lodging the complaint police have arrested the accused, effected spot panchanama, recorded the statements of witnesses and now only the charge sheet is remained to be filed. It seems that further custody of applicant is not required in the matter. So on certain conditions, applicant is entitled to bail considering the nature of the case. Hence I answer the points accordingly and proceed to pass the

following order.

ORDER

1] Application is allowed as under :-

The applicant Yogesh Subhash Sanap be released on bail, in connection with CR No.15/2014 registered at Wakad Police Station, under Section 354 of IPC and under S. 11 r/w 12 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, on executing SB and PB of Rs.25,000/- with one or two sureties in the like amount, on following conditions.

- A] The applicant shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence in any manner.
- B] The applicant shall co-operate with police for further investigation.
- C] The applicant shall attend the Court on given date.
- D] The applicant shall attend concerned police station on last Sunday of each month in between 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. till filing of the charge-sheet.
- E] The applicant shall not enter within the residential area of complainant, not to contact her, meet her, tease her and harass her.
