Mr. Tanuj Dogra, ld. Counsel for both accused persons.

Ld. Counsel for accused submits that no offence is made out against Sapna Sehgal. The allegations against her are vague and as such, she is liable to be discharged. Ld. Counsel for the accused further submits that in so far as Rahul Sehgal is concerned there is a cross FIR bearing No.119/2025 PS Subzi Mandi wherein, the complainant herein, alongwith her husband had given beatings to Sapna and his son Meet. It is submitted that accused are liable to be discharged.

On the other hand, ld. Addl. PP for the state submits that there is prima facie material for framing of charge against the accused persons.

I have heard ld. Counsels for the parties and perused the record.

In the present case, complainant R.K. (name withheld in order to protect her identity) alleged that on 07/03/2025, while she came back from her school, she heard the noise of children playing, she asked them not to play as Board examinations were going on, upon which son of Rahul Sehgal stated that he would

play. Immediately, thereafter, Rahul Sehgal and his wife Sapna came and started abusing her. Accused Rahul threatened to kill her and her husband. Some people from outside collected and started pacifying the matter. Despite that Rahul did not mend his ways. After sometime, police came and then Rahul and Sapna came downstairs and in the presence of police officials with a cricket bat started hitting the complainant. Sapna also started giving beatings. Complainant reiterated these allegations in her statement u/s 183 BNSS. Both the accused have been named in the FIR. The complainant has levelled specific allegations that accused Sapna had also given beatings.

At this stage, there are sufficient material for framing of charge against the accused persons.

Application for discharge stands dismissed.

Accordingly, a common charge U/s 115(2)/3(5)BNS is framed against both accused persons and separate charge U/s 74/351(2)/79/75(2) BNS has been framed against accused Rahul Sehgal to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

Put up for PE on **14/10/2026**. Let witnesses mentioned at Sl. No. 1 & 4 be summoned for the next date of hearing.
