Counsel for the appellant and the grounds under the present appeal, demonstrating a *prima facie* case, the operation of impugned **order of sentence is suspended till the next date of hearing**, on the appellant depositing 20% of the fine amount, as directed under the said impugned order of sentence **in the name of this Court (Additional Sessions Judge-03, Central, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi)** as well as on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- along with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Ld. JMFC/Ld. Duty JMFC. Let the bail bonds be furnished within a period of seven days from today.

In the interest of justice, list for further proceedings on **19.05.2025**.

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A copy of this order be given *dasti* to Ld Counsel for the appellant.

A copy of this order be also sent to the Ld. Trial Court for information purposes.

TCR be requisitioned two days, prior to the next date of hearing.
