Fresh bail application under Section 483 BNSS filed on behalf of applicant / accused Priya. It be checked and registered.

IO has filed reply to the bail application.

Applicant / accused is seeking regular bail under Section 483 BNSS for the offences punishable under Sections 110/ 3 (5) / 191/ 191 (2) / 191 (3) BNS in FIR No. 156/2026 PS Civil Lines.

It is submitted that the present matter arises out of mutual altercation between the parties and a cross FIR has also been registered against the complainant and his associates based on the complaint of the applicant's family. The existence of cross FIR clearly demonstrates that the applicant and her family were

themselves victims of aggression by the other side. Investigation qua applicant has already been complete and she is no more required for any custodial investigation. It is further submitted parties have amicably settled their dispute and a compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

I have Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused, Ld. Prosecutor for State and also gone through the reply of the investigating officer.

The present is a case of assault by use of brickbats, stones and wooden sticks wherein two groups assaulted each other and sustained injuries. Cross FIRs bearing no.156/2026 and 157/2026 PS Civil Lines have been registered against both the groups. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and since, the applicant / accused has no criminal antecedents, she is admitted is bail on her furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of concerned Ld. JMFC / Duty JMFC on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The applicant / accused shall keep her mobile phone on at all times.
2. The applicant / accused is directed not to threat/contact the complainant/injured in any manner.
3. The applicant / accused shall intimate the IO as and when she changes her address.
4. The applicant shall not leave the country without

permission of the court.

Application is accordingly disposed of.
