Reply has already been filed on behalf of respondents.

Present transfer petition has been filed seeking transfer of complaint case bearing no.511751/2016, '*Rekha Aggarwal vs Monika Sharma*' from the court of Sh.Arjun Kirar, Ld. JMFC (NI Act)-05 (Central) to the court of Sh.Arvind Tomar, Ld. JMFC (NI Act)-7 (Central) where another complaint case bearing no.516303/2016, titled '*Manoj Aggarwal vs Monika Sharma*' is pending.

Transfer petition is opposed on behalf of respondents and it is submitted by Ld. Counsel that both the cases are pending in different courts since the year 2016. The trial of the case '*Rekha Aggarwal vs Monika Sharma*' stands concluded and it is fixed for final arguments whereas trial of the case '*Manoj Aggarwal vs Monika Sharma*' is pending at the stage of complainant's evidence.

On the other hand, it is submitted by counsel for petitioner that both cases relate to the same transaction and accused Monika Sharma is common in both the cases, although complainants are husband and wife.

Considering overall facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the opinion that present petition cannot be allowed. Case '*Rekha Aggarwal vs Monika Sharma*' is ripe for judgment and therefore, it is not appropriate to transfer the case at the stage of final arguments. Even otherwise both the cases have been pending in separate courts for last more than 10 years. Therefore, no justification arises to transfer the case. Transfer application is accordingly dismissed.
