**Fresh bail application under Section 483 BNSS filed on behalf of applicant / accused Tausif. It be checked and registered.**

IO has filed reply to the bail application.

Applicant / accused is seeking regular bail under Section 483 BNSS for the offences punishable under Sections 110/ 3 (5) / 191/ 191 (2) / 191 (3) BNS in FIR No. 156/2026 PS Civil Lines.

It is submitted that the cross FIRs were registered vide FIR No. 156/2026 and 157/2026 and the all injured have been discharged from the hospital. Investigation qua applicant has already been complete and he is no more required for any custodial investigation. Co-accused persons have already been granted bail.

I have Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused, Ld. Prosecutor for State and also gone through the reply of the investigating officer.

The present is a case of assault by use of brickbats, stones and wooden sticks wherein two groups assaulted each other and sustained injuries. Cross FIRs bearing no.156/2026 and 157/2026 PS Civil Lines have been registered against both the groups. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and since the applicant / accused has no criminal antecedents and co-accused persons have already been granted bail, he is admitted is bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of concerned Ld. JMFC / Duty JMFC on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The applicant / accused shall keep his mobile phone on at all times.
2. The applicant / accused is directed not to threat/contact the complainant/injured in any manner.
3. The applicant / accused shall intimate the IO as and when he changes his address.
4. The applicant shall not leave the country without permission of the court.

Application is accordingly disposed of.
