Applicant /accused Satish Kumar is seeking regular bail for the offences punishable under Section 304 (2) / 3 (5) BNS.

As per the FIR, the accused was involved in snatching of purse from the complainant who is an auto driver.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that the accused is in judicial custody since 09.01.2026 and has been falsely implicated. No recovery has been effected from the accused. Investigation has been completed and the charge-sheet has been filed and he is no more required for any investigation.

I have heard Ld. Counsel for applicant, Ld. Addl PP for State and the reply of the investigating officer along with previous involvement report.

Considering the facts and circumstances and since the investigation in the present case has been completed and the charge-sheet has been filed and accused has already been acquitted in the case in which he was involved earlier, applicant / accused is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of concerned Ld. JMFC / Duty JMFC on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The applicant / accused is directed not to contact the complainant or any other prosecution witness in any manner.
2. The applicant / accused shall intimate the IO as and when he changes his address.
3. The applicant shall not leave the country without permission of the court.
4. The applicant / accused shall keep his mobile phone on at all times so that he can be contacted.
5. The applicant shall appear before the trial court on each and every date of hearing in the present case.

Application is accordingly disposed of.
