I.A.No. 12/2026:- This is an application seeking cancellation of NBW on behalf of accused Rajan.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submits that one opportunity may be granted to the applicant/accused and there was some mis-communication between the earlier counsel and the applicant.

Heard.

Perusal of the file shows that accused Rajan has not been regularly appearing since 28.02.2025. He did not appear on 23.05.2025, warrants were issued which were cancelled on 25.07.2025 thereafter on 15.09.2025 and 21.11.2025 accused chose not to appear, even surety was also absent despite service of notice.

I find no reason to allow the application seeking cancellation of NBW. Application stands dismissed. Accused is taken into custody.
