**INTERIM BAIL APPLICATION OF APPLICANT RAJAN**

1. This is an application seeking interim bail filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Rajan (hereinafter referred to as applicant).
2. It is argued by the ld. Counsel for the applicant that the applicant is in J.C. since 07.04.2022. It is further argued that the younger brother of the applicant has expired on 28.01.2023 and due to the said reason, the applicant is seeking interim bail for a period of one month for teharvi and other hawan ceremony of his younger brother. It is prayed that applicant be released on interim bail.
3. The application for grant of interim bail to the applicant/accused is strongly opposed by the ld. Addl. PP with the assistance of IO SI Gajpal Singh. It is submitted that the offence committed by the applicant is serious in nature. It is further submitted that the applicant may commit similar

offence. It is further submitted that the applicant may jump the bail, if granted. It is prayed that the interim bail application of the applicant/accused Rajan be dismissed.

4. Heard. Record perused.
5. The applicant is not found involved in similar cases previously. The younger brother of the applicant, aged about 19 years is reported to have expired and this fact has been confirmed by the IO. The present interim bail is sought for performing tehrvi and last ceremonies of the deceased.
6. Considering the facts and circumstances, on humanitarian grounds, the applicant Rajan is admitted to interim bail for a period of 15 days from the date of release, on filing of P/B and S/B in a sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to the condition that the applicant shall not try to contact, influence or threaten the prosecution witnesses in any manner whatsoever.
7. Application stands disposed of in above terms.
8. Copy of this order be given dasti to ld. Counsel for applicant/accused.
9. Copy of this order be also sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary action.
