This is an application for extension of interim bail filed on behalf of applicant Rajan s/o. Sh. Balak Ram.

It is submitted by the Counsel for the applicant that the applicant was granted interim bail vide order dated 07.02.2023 for a period of 15 days, on the ground of Tehrvi of his younger brother.

It is submitted by Counsel for applicant that the applicant was released from jail on 24.02.2023 as he was already in J.C. in some other case. It is further submitted that date of surrender of the applicant was 11.03.2023 but he did not surrender till today.

The Addl. PP for the State opposed the present application.

Heard.

The applicant was bound to surrender on 11.03.2023 (as stated by the Counsel for the applicant) after expiry of the interim bail of 15 days but the applicant has not complied with the bail order. The brother of the applicant was stated to have expired on 28.01.2023. Much time has elapsed since the expiry of the brother of the applicant.

No grounds for extension of interim bail is made out and the application is accordingly dismissed.
