This is bail application under Section 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail filed on behalf of accused Ram Parvesh.

This is first bail application. It is stated that the applicant/accused have been falsely implicated in this case and nothing has been recovered from the possession of the applicant/accused and whatever recovery has been shown is planted one. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is the sole bread earner of his family and is a very poor person. It is submitted that first bail application of the applicant/accused was dismissed by the Court of Ld. ACJM on 05.05.2026. It is further stated that applicant/accused is ready and willing to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the Court. Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused prayed for grant of bail.

I have heard the Ld. Counsels for the parties and gone through the record carefully.

The present application has been moved by the applicant/accused before the Court of Ld. ASJ/FTC-02 on 08.06.2026 and the TCR has been summoned by the Court for

11.06.2026. Charge sheet received from the Court of Ld. CJM.

I have gone through the record carefully.

There are allegations against the accused that in the facts and circumstances of case there is reasonable grounds to believe that the death of the victim was the consumption of liquor mixed with an unknown intoxicated poisonous substance given by the accused. It is revealed during investigation that accused knowingly gave the said intoxicated poisonous substance or excessive quantity of liquor to the victim with the intention to facilitate theft of his rickshaw and mobile phone and he left the victim in intoxicated condition inside Ashok Vihar Park during cold weather thereby endangering his life. In the charge sheet, it is also mentioned that viscera report is still awaited and final report regarding the exact cause of death shall be ascertained on receipt of the same. As there are serious allegations against the applicant/accused and accused is facing trial for the offences under Section 303(2)/123/105/309(6)/317(2) BNS, I am not inclined to grant bail to the accused. The application of the applicant/accused is dismissed. Copy of the order be given Dasti. TCR be sent back to the Court concerned.
