Four separate applications under Section 187 of BNSS
2023 read with Section 65 of Prevention of Money Laundering Act
seeking 14 days judicial custody of the accused Rajnish Mittal,
Atul Gupta, Avdhesh Kumar Goel and Vikas Gupta have been
moved.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the present case and since the investigation is at its initial stage and is continuing against the accused persons, accused Rajnish Mittal, Atul Gupta, Avdhesh Kumar Goel and Vikas Gupta are remanded to Judicial custody till 19.06.2026.

Applications for judicial custody are accordingly disposed of.

An application is moved on behalf of accused Avdesh Kumar Goel seeking directions to Jail Superintendent to provide spectacles, certain medicines and books during judicial custody. Similar application has been moved on behalf of accused Rajnish Mittal to take with him spectacles, water bottle, handkerchief and documents during judicial custody. Another application moved on behalf of accused Vikas Gupta seeking permission for taking medical equipment (ResMed AirSense 10 CPAP Machine) during custody.

All the applications are to be dealt with by Jail Authorities and after getting the medical examination of the accused persons, if need arises, medicine and other things are to be provided as per jail rules. However, accused persons are permitted to take their spectacles during custody.

Accused persons be produced on 19.06.2026 before Vacation Judge (may be through video conferencing).
