ORDER

1. The application is allowed. P. I., Borakhedi Police Station is directed to hand over the interim custody of Motor Cycle Reg. No. MH-28-BH-0863 of Bajaj Motors Ltd. company's Discover motor cycle, seized in connection with C.R. No. 428/2022 to the applicant. Applicant to execute the indemnity bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) before this Court.
2. The applicant shall not transfer said property nor it's nature shall be changed, till the final disposal of the case.
3. The applicant shall produce said property before this court or trial court as and when directed by the Court till the final disposal of the case.
4. The I.O. is directed to take the photographs of the Property at the cost of applicant. Applicant shall file those photographs before this Court alongwith chargesheet.
