At this stage, upon an enquiry, it is brought to the attention of this Court that the summons were belatedly prepared, hence, the same could not be served upon the witness on time. Accordingly, *Ahlmad* / Asst. *Ahlmad* are warned to be careful in future.

Issue fresh **summons against PW1 Rahul Ravinder Pandey and PW2 Mr. Jesal Sahdev along with IO** for next date of hearing, **to be issued today itself.**

Further, the **concerned IO is directed to appear before the Court along with a laptop** in order to enable playing of relevant video recording / CCTV recording on next date of hearing.

At this stage, an application is moved on behalf of the accused, namely, Rahul seeking directions to the concerned

Jail Superintendent to have the accused produced in the Court in separate *kharja*.

Issue notice of the application to the concerned Jail Superintendent to provide feedback / comments on or before the next date of hearing on the said application i.e. on 14.10.2023.
