ORDER:

1 This application for regular bail has been moved on behalf of applicant-accused Gurpreet Kaur @ Gura for offences under Sections 15 and 29 of NDPS Act by virtue of Section 439 Cr.P.C..

2 Notice of this bail application has been given to State. Police record has been received and perused and arguments have been heard.

3 As per allegations, on 08.09.2022, SI Surjit Singh along with other police officials i.e. HC Daljit Singh, C.Harmanpreet Singh, LC Amandeep Kaur, on Govt. Vehicle No.PB13AW-4105 along with laptop, etc., in connection with patrolling and checking of suspected persons and

vehicle, were present at Ludhiana Malerkotla Main Road Bus Stand Kup Kalan. At about 6.00 p.m., SI Surjit Singh received secret information that Swaran Singh alias Mast son of Mohinder Singh resident of Akbarpur Chhanna and Gurpreet Kaur alias Gura wife of Fakiria resident of village Kanganwal, were habitual of bringing poppy husk from outside and to sell the same and on that day, that Swaran Singh alias Mast and Gurpreet Kaur alias Gura, in car bearing no.PB-32F-8114 make Scorpio of black would proceed from village Akbarpur Chhanna towards village Jandali for selling such poppy husk to their customers and if nakabandi would be held at the road road to link road village Jandali, then the aforesaid persons could be apprehended along with poppy husk in huge quantity. Considering that information to be reliable, SI Surjit Singh sent a ruqa to the police station for registration of case against the aforesaid persons for offence under Section 15 of NDPS Act. SI Surjit Singh also talked to Inspector Gurpreet Singh Incharge CIA Mahorana in this regard and he also requested to send another Investigating Officer on the spot.

After some time, another Investigating Officer SI Nirbhai Singh came at the spot and met SI Surjit Singh and other police officials. Thereafter, SI Nirbhai Singh held nakabandi at the relevant place. During that process, one car make Scorpio was seen coming from Ludhiana Malerkotla Road and that car was signalled to spot but the driver of the car became nervous and when he tried to turn his car towards backside for the sake of fleeing that car was stopped. The driver of that car and one lady sitted in that car were apprehended. On being asked, the driver of

that car disclosed his name as Swaran Singh alias Mast son of Mohinder Singh resident of Akbarpur Chhanna, P.S. Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla and the lady sitted in that car disclosed her name as Gurpreet Kaur alias Gura wife of Fakiria resident of village Kanganwal, PS Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla. One checking, one heavy plastic bag was found lying at the floor behind the seat of driver side and the mouth of that bag was opened from which poppy husk was clearly visible. That plastic bag was taken out from the car. On weighment along with bag, it came to 14 Kgs. and thereafter, that bag was converted into parcel and was sealed by SI Nirbhai Singh with his seal bearing impression 'NS' and the same was into police possession and accused were arrested.

4. It may be submitted at the very outset that as per the allegations that the recovery so effected from the possession of applicant-accused Gurpreet Kaur @ Gura, is that of 14 Kgs. of poppy husk. Although it appears that such recovery comes within the preview of non-commercial quantity but till date report of FSL has not come. Applicant-accused Gurpreet Kaur @ Gura is in custody since 08.09.2022. In these circumstances, applicant-accused Gurpreet Kaur @ Gura is admitted to interim bail till the receipt of report of FSL and subject to her furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Id. Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following conditions:-

- 1 That applicant will appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing during trial without fail;

- 2 That applicant will not leave the Country without prior permission of the Court;
- 3 That applicant will not induce the prosecution witnesses as well as will not tamper the prosecution evidence, in any manner.

It is made clear that this concession of interim bail shall be reconsidered on receipt of report of FSL. Police record be returned. Bail application file be attached with the connected papers of this case and accused shall appear on date fixed.
