Accused is absent.

The Ld. Counsel for the accused submits that he is not carrying the file and the accused is unavailable due to ill health of her child. Upon enquiry, the Ld. Counsel for the accused has not been able to tell the particulars of ailment.

The AR of the complainant submits that the matter was settled on 15.12.2023 for a total amount of Rs. 70,000/- out of which the accused has not paid anything. He has also shown the statement of account of the accused.

The Ld. Counsel for the accused submits that the accused has made all the payments duly. No proof of payment has been shown.

For her default and absence the accused is burdened with a cost of Rs. 5,000/- payable to the complainant.

It appears that the accused is deliberately avoiding the trial. Accordingly, this court is constrained to issue Non Bailable Warrants against the accused on filing of PF through concerned SHO, returnable on the NDOH.
