This is an application u/s 483 BNSS moved on behalf
of applicant/accused Jatin @ Vikas seeking regular bail.

IO has filed reply to the present application.

Submissions on the bail application heard and record
perused.

Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused submits that the
applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in
the present case. It is further submitted that the
applicant/accused was not even present at the place of alleged
incident. It is further submitted that no specific role has been
assigned to the applicant/accused in the entire complaint and that
the applicant/accused had come to Rohini Court for legal
consultation with his Counsel in connection with another pending
case and that no incriminating article/weapon of offence has been
recovered from the applicant/accused. It is further submitted that
the applicant/accused had neither assaulted the complainant nor
assisted any person in commission of the alleged offence. It is
further submitted that the investigation qua the applicant/accused
are already complete and that the applicant/accused is in JC since

15.05.2026 and it will take considerably long time to conclude the trial.

It is further submitted by the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused that no other bail application of the applicant/accused is pending consideration before any Superior Courts or any other Court.

Ld. Addl. PP for the State has strongly opposed the present application and has prayed for its dismissal contending that the applicant/accused was actively involved in a criminal conspiracy whereby CCL 'MR' S/o 'MP' attacked on complainant/victim/UTP Rohit with sharp edged weapon/blade. It is further contended that it was the applicant/accused had accompanied the CCL along with other accused namely Manish and one other person locally known *Tamaatar* and they had carried out the said attack on the instruction of one person namely Harsh @ Boxer who had shared photos of the victim with the applicant/accused Vikas @ Jatin. It is further submitted that it was the applicant/accused who had pointed towards the victim and on his pointing, the CCL had attacked on the complainant/victim with blades. It is further contended that the CCTV footage of Rohini Courts also shows the applicant/accused with the aforesaid CCL and other accused persons. It is further contended that the applicant/accused is also previously involved in similar offence of attempt to murder and culpable homicide and he was present at the spot. It is further contended that the

investigations are still continuing as the co-accused are yet to be apprehended.

I have heard Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused, Ld. Addl. PP for the State and have perused the record.

Perusal of record reveals that the case punishable for the offence u/s 109(1)/61 BNS has been registered against the accused persons. The allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature i.e. criminal conspiracy in attempt to murder. The investigation is at the initial stage and other accused persons are yet to be arrested. As per reply filed by the IO, there is CCTV footage which is incriminating against the applicant/accused. Further, the applicant/accused is found involved in two other criminal cases as well and chances of his absconding or indulging in similar kind of crime cannot be ruled out if he is released on bail.

In the above facts and circumstances and in view of nature and gravity of offence, no ground is made out to grant bail to the applicant/accused, at this stage. **The present bail application is accordingly dismissed.**

It is clarified that nothing stated herein shall tantamount to an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the Ld. Counsel for the accused and to the IO and be also sent to Jail Superintendent concerned and to DLSA North, Delhi for

information.

The present bail application accordingly stands disposed of.
