

Union Bank of India Vs. Soni

Present : Sh. K.S. Ranot, Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff.

Office reports that pages No. 28 to 38 of the paper book are not properly legible.

Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submitted that the GPA at pages 28 to 38 of the paper book is an old GPA and that the original shall be produced as and when directed.

Ld. Counsel further submitted that the certificate under Section 63 BSA, 2023 in respect of the computer generated statement of account shall be filed within ten days.

It emerges that though pre suit interest has been claimed however, the amount has not been computed towards the valuation and for the purposes of Court fees.

Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff submitted that as the pre suit interest is for a negligible period of three four months only, therefore the plaintiff is not claiming any pre suit interest and is restricting its claim to pendente lite and future interest only.

In view of the submission made, the prayer clause is required to be amended.

Plaintiff to take the steps in this regard before the next date.
