ORDER BELOW APPLICATION FOR RETURN OF PROPERTY :

1. Perused application, say of learned APP, I.O. and documents on record. Applicant **Pranit Rajesh Temkar** prayed for return of property i.e. Yamaha black metallic X motor cycle bearing Reg.no.MH-02-FS-3554, Ch.no.ME1SEJ27AM0010987, Engine no.E33SE0087650, Mfg. Year October, 2021, valued Rs.1,00,000/-, which is seized in C.R No.73/2022 under seizure panchanama by Amboli Police Station. Say of I.O and Ld APP were called. I.O. has objected to return of the said property to the applicant. Ld APP has submitted that the present applicant is registered owner of the seized motor cycle. Hence, conditions may kindly be imposed. Applicant has produced Affidavit, xerox copy of R.C.Book, Driving licence, insurance policy, Xerox copy of Aadhar Card and FIR on record. The said seized property is lying at police station. Applicant is the owner of the said property. So the property will be returned to the applicant at interim stage, with the following condition, then no harm will be caused to anybody. I, therefore, pass following order;

ORDER

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1. The application is hereby allowed.
 2. The concerned police station is hereby directed to hand over the seized property i.e. Yamaha black metallic X motor cycle bearing Reg.no.MH-02-FS-3554, Ch.no.ME1SEJ27AM0010987, Engine no.E33SE0087650, Mfg. Year October, 2021, valued Rs.1,00,000/-, which is seized in C.R No.73/2022 under seizure panchanama on his

executing indemnity bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One lack Only) to applicant **Pranit Rajesh Temkar**.

3. The concerned police officer is hereby directed to hand over the said property to the applicant, after taking all the details i.e. photographs, description, etc. which ever is necessary.

4. The applicant is hereby directed not to sell, change, transfer, or exchange the said property in any manner to anybody till the disposal of the case.

5. The applicant is hereby directed to produce the said property before the Court as and when required and ordered by this Court.

6. The applicant is hereby directed to obey the order of the Court, whichever will be passed time to time.

7. In failure of this applicant is responsible for legal action.
