

**16 CC NI ACT / 15524/2026 VIKRAM SINGH Vs. NAVDEEP
KAUR (Nazafgarh)
07.05.2026**

Present: Complainant in person.

This is the complaint for offence punishable u/s 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Complainant tendered his evidence as PW-1 and discharged.

Arguments heard on the point of summoning. All statutory requirements under NI Act are complied with. The present complaint filed within limitations. After perusal of the entire record, this court is of the considered view that a *prima facie* case punishable u/s 138 NI Act is made out against the accused.

Issue summons to the accused through approved registered courier, speed post and email for **22.08.2026**. The complainant is directed to file PF and take steps within seven days. Complainant is directed to supply the copy of complete set of documents filed in the court including evidence affidavit of complainant.

The complainant is further directed to file the last known verified address(s) of the accused on affidavit. Ahlmad is directed to issue the summons only after ensuring that the same has been done.

Ahlmad is directed to make the following endorsements on the summons in terms of the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in the case of **Damodar S. Prabhu Vs. Sayed Babalal H. (2010) 5 SCC 663**:

Complainant is directed to file the process fee and postal envelops physically, mentioning the details of the case etc. for issuance of summons to the accused.

Put up for appearance of accused on **22.08.2026**.
