compensation? If so, to what amount and

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has filed an application seeking direction to get the disability assessed. He has also filed the form 'J'. The same is taken on record.

Heard and perused.

Issue notice upon the Medical Superintendent, Hindu Rao hospital, New Delhi to get the petitioner examined by a Medical Board for the purpose of ascertaining Orthopedic/permanent disability, if any, and the extent of disability. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Office of Medical Superintendent, Hindu Rao hospital, New Delhi, New Delhi within 15 days.

The Medical Superintendent/Medical Board shall be at liberty to fix any other date convenient to them for the medical examination of the petitioner and to send the report/disability certificate directly to this Tribunal within 15 days along with an attested copy of the records of medical examination carried out for the purpose of assessment of disability. A copy of the same be also provided to the petitioner.

Accordingly, application stands disposed off.

Copy of this order along with original 'Form J' bearing photograph of claimant and copy of discharge summary/MLC be given to the petitioner who shall produce the same before the concerned Medical Superintendent.

Ld. Counsels for the parties submit that they shall take steps for settlement.
