ORDER

Police record is produced.

Heard. Interim anticipatory bail was granted by this Court to
the petitioner by passing the following order :-

“Fresh bail application under section 438 Cr.P.C. filed.
Entrusted to self. It be registered.

Heard. It is alleged case of release of the fire-arm of
deceased Vishal Sharma, without any authority. In the meanwhile, the
petitioner is directed to join the investigation within seven days from
today and in case of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the
satisfaction of Arresting Officer/investigating officer, subject to his
complying all the provisions of Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C. Copy of this
order be sent to the concerned police station for compliance.

Notice of the bail application be issued to the State for
31.7.2020. Police record be produced by way of forwarding soft copy to
the Court of undersigned, one day before the next date of hearing.”

Statement of Investigating Officer i.e ASI Rajesh Kumar has
been recorded. According to him, petitioner has joined the investigation
and now he is no more required for custodial interrogation. So, keeping in
view such circumstances, and the reasons mentioned in the interim
anticipatory bail order dated 6.7.2020, I am of the opinion that police

custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. Therefore, interim anticipatory bail order dated 6.7.2020 is made absolute by allowing this

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bail application, subject to his complying the provisions of section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Police record be returned. File be consigned to the record room.
